9-208. Suspension or revocation of permit

- (1) <u>Suspension by the recorder.</u> The permit issued to any person or organization under this chapter may be suspended by the <u>Commissioner of Finance</u> for any of the following causes:
 - (a) Any false statement, material omission, or untrue or misleading information which is contained in or left out of the application; or
 - (b) Any violation of this chapter.
- (2) Suspension or revocation by the City Council. The permit issued to any person or organization under this chapter may be suspended or revoked by the board of mayor and aldermen, after notice and hearing, for the same causes set out in paragraph (1) above. Notice of the hearing for suspension or revocation of a permit shall be given by the city recorder in writing, setting forth specifically the grounds of complaint and the time and place of the hearing. Such notice shall be mailed to the permit holder at his last known address at least five days prior to the date set for hearing, or it shall be delivered by a police officer in the same manner as a summons at least three (3) days prior to the date set for hearing.
