Due to the passing of a new Lebanon Municipal Code, the sale and use of fireworks has been permitted inside the Lebanon city limits. **Limitations include, but are not limited to the following:**

1. *The use of fireworks is only permitted from June 20 until July 5.*
2. Fireworks may only be discharged between the hours of 10am-10pm.
3. Children under the age of 18 years of age are prohibited from buying or using fireworks, unless that child is under the supervision of a guardian.
4. It is unlawful to explode or ignite fireworks within 600 feet of any church, hospital, funeral home, public or private school, or within 200 feet of where fireworks are stored, sold, or offered for sale.
5. No person shall ignite or discharge any permissible articles of fireworks within or throw the same from a motor vehicle while within, nor shall any person place, shoot, or throw any ignited article of fireworks into or at such a motor vehicle, or at or near any person or group of persons.

Please always use caution when discharging fireworks. We hope you have a safe and happy Fourth of July.
